By this letter, the Port of Morrow withdraws the Intent to Award dated 04/25/16 for the above described scope of work (High Speed Roll up Freezer Doors) from Mid-Columbia Forklift.

Further Review has determined that it is in the best interest of the Port of Morrow **Not** to proceed with the Intent to Award to Mid-Columbia Forklift per the following.

Justification for withdraw: Under ORS 279C.375(2)(d), the bidder must be "legally qualified to contract with the contracting agency." ORS 279C.365(1)(k) provides that: A contracting agency may not receive or consider a bid for a public improvement contract unless the bidder is licensed by the Construction Contractors Board or the State Landscape Contractors Board."
