The Experience:

Beef Northwest is offering a summer Pasture Rider Internship at Boardman, Oregon. The position is a paid full-time internship. The purpose of the internship is to teach riders the key elements of animal health, stockman ship, and horsemanship in cattle feeding operation. Ultimately, this will help Beef Northwest determine if you are a strong candidate for its Manager in Training Program post-graduation.

Job Duties:

- Ride pastures per daily schedule identifying sickness and injuries
- Accurately record all sick 'pulled' cattle removed from pens on pull slip
- Accurately record pens ridden on cowboy pen map daily before end of shift
- Move cattle safely from pen to pen as directed
- Assist in sorting fat cattle as needed and directed
- Assist in loading and unloading cattle trucks as per schedule
- Furnish their own tack and four well broke horses
- Feed & care for those horses
- Assist in processing cattle as directed
- Assist in doctoring cattle as required
- Maintain yard housekeeping standards
- Other tasks or duties as required by supervisor

- Strong desire to work in the Cattle and/or Feed Lot Industry postgraduation
- Strong work ethic and a positive can-do attitude
- Has had exposure to identifying sick & injured cattle
- Basic cattle handling skills
- Good horsemanship skills and access to a horse to ride for the summer
- Must be able to count cattle accurately
- Horse & cattle background is essential
- Excellent safety skills and awareness needed
