- You will be preparing a SWOT analysis for each department for your final Internship presentation.
- You will be working on one to three projects. Those projects will include scope, benefit, drawbacks, financial analysis and your final recommendation.
- You will visit multiple BNW sites and operations.
- You will visit industry partners.
- You will be exposed to all aspects of the business in one way or another.
- At the end of your Internship you will deliver a presentation of your summer experience and projects to the Executive Leadership team, Managers and staff at multiple locations.
