II. NEW BUSINESS

A. Leases and Agreements

Joe read the executive session statement and closed the open session at 1:43 PM.

Rick made a motion to authorize Lisa to continue to negotiate and, upon completion, sign the following agreements in good faith with Madison Ranches, Inc.: Water Delivery and Application Agreement, Agricultural Sublease, Ground Lease in Reference to a Pond, and Municipal Industrial Water Agreement Use for Agricultural Irrigation. Rick made a motion to authorize Lisa to negotiate in good faith the Farm Management Agreement. The motion was withdrawn by Rick for further discussion. Sam and Kirk provided comments and guidance. The commission provided a consensus agreement for Lisa to proceed. She will bring a draft back to the commission for final approval.
