What is it?

The industry led high school internship program is open to high school juniors and seniors who:

- Are on track to graduate
- OSAA Eligible

Student Employer

Students will be employees of InterMountain ESD. IMESD will pay each student minimum wage (\$12.50).

High School Credit

Available based on attendance, number of hours worked, and capstone project.

Student Responsibilities

Please review prior to applying:

- Visit with your high school counselor about eligibility.
- Review extracurricular activity schedule for the year to know your availability.
- Review each job description to see if the position is a good fit for your career and education plans.
- Talk with your patent/guardian about the opportunity.
- Review the Internship Employment Guide to review information for building a resume, cover letter, and asking for a letter of recommendation.

How does it work?

- 1. Determine if you qualify
- Identify potential job opportunities aligned with career goals (see job intern list)
- 3. Apply by the deadline

When is the timeline?

- Positions open on the IMESD website on March 1, 2024. *Click on the QR Code below to see jobs.*
- Application period closes April 5, 2024.
- Interviews will be held April 23-24, 2024, with student notification to follow
- Students will start internships in September 2024.
