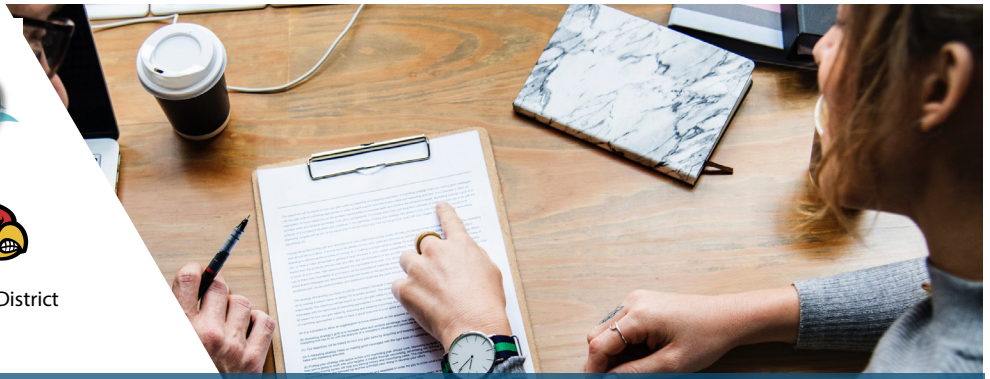

What is it?

The industry led high school internship program is open to high school juniors and seniors who:

- Are on track to graduate
- OSAA eligible

Student Employer

Students will be employees of InterMountain ESD. IMESD will pay each student minimum wage (\$12.00).

High School Credit

Available based on attendance, number of hours worked and capstone project.

Student Responsibilities

Please review prior to applying:

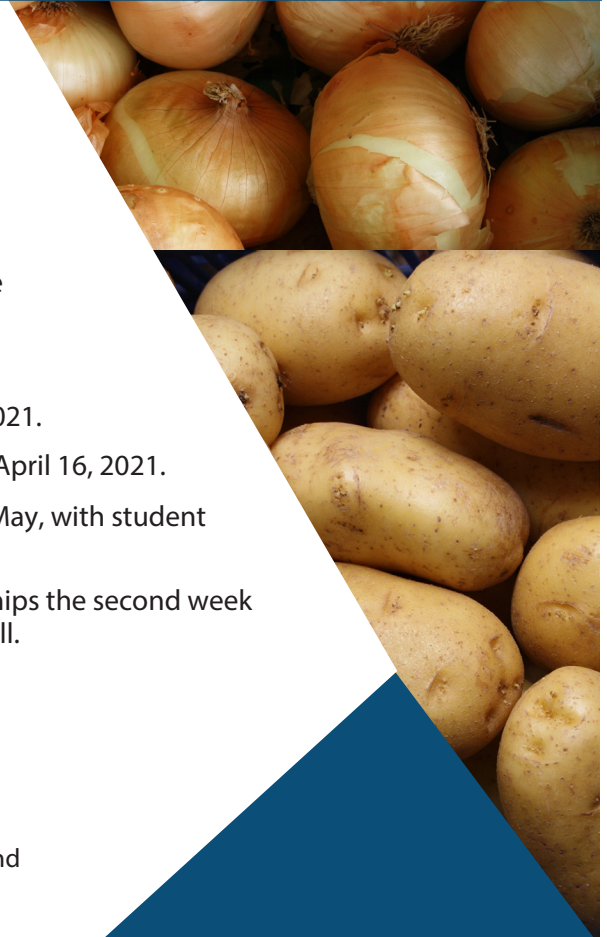
- Visit with your high school counselor about eligibility.
- Review extracurricular activity schedule for the year to know your availability.
- Review each job description to see if the position is a good fit for your career and education plans.
- Talk with your parent/guardian about the opportunity.
- Review the Internship Employment Guide to review information for building a resume, cover letter, and asking for a letter of recommendation.

How does it work?

1. Determine if you qualify
2. Identify potential job opportunities aligned with career goals (see job intern list)
3. Apply by the April deadline

When is the timeline?

- Positions open March 1, 2021.
- Application period closes April 16, 2021.
- Interviews will be held in May, with student notification to follow.
- Students will start internships the second week of the school year in the fall.
